

KNOW THE COSMOS...

Q: DOES SPACE SMELL?

Ans: Yes, space does smell! The most wistful theory about this is that the smell of space is the leftover aroma of dying stars. There's an awful lot of combustion going on in the universe. Stars mostly comprise of Hydrogen and Helium gas, powered by a nuclear fusion reaction that can last for billions of years. At the end of its life, as the hydrogen fuel is used up, a star will collapse on itself and undergo a violent supernova explosion, during which heavier elements such as oxygen, carbon, gold and uranium will be produced. All these rampant combustions produce smelly compounds called 'polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons. These molecules are thought to pervade the universe and float around forever. This causes space to smell.

Q: HOW DO ASTRONAUTS WEIGH THEMSELVES IN SPACE?

Ans: In space, astronauts cannot measure their weight directly, because they are in freefall and so their weight is essentially zero. However, by measuring mass, they can determine what their weight on Earth would be. To measure their mass, astronauts usually use a Russian device called Body Mass Measurement Device (BMMD), which is a bit like a pogo-stick with a compressed spring. Astronauts first curl their body around the BMMD, hold on it tight and then release the spring, gently travelling up and down whilst the device measures the frequency of oscillation. By first calibrating the BMMD and by knowing the stiffness of the spring, the device can accurately determine an astronaut's mass.

Q: DOES THE INTERNATIONAL SPACE STATION HAVE WI-FI?

Ans: Yes! The ISS has Wi-Fi provided by a couple of Bel Air Wireless Access Points in the US segment. This is used to connect devices on the operations network, though, not for astronaut's personal internet use.

Q: ARE THERE ANY LONG-TERM EFFECTS OF SPACEFLIGHT?

Ans: Yes, there are many long term health effects of spaceflight. Some of them are – muscle deterioration, bone deterioration, visual impairment, radiation exposure which eventually may cause cancer, vascular ageing, back/ neck pain and depleted immune system.

MY IDOL-DR. APJ ABDUL KALAM

Dr APJ Abdul Kalam (Abdul PakirJainulabdeen Abdul Kalam) was born on 15 October 1931. He was an Indian Aerospace scientist who served as the 11th President of India from 2002 to 2007. He was born and raised in Rameshwaram, Tamil Nadu and studied physics and aerospace engineering. He spent the next four decades as a scientist and Science administrator, mainly at the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) and Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) and was intimately involved in India's Civilian Space program and military missile development efforts.

He thus came to be known as the Missile Man of India for his work on the development of ballistic missile and launch vehicle Technology. He also played a pivotal organisational, technical and political role in India's Pokhran-11 nuclear test in 1998, the first since the original nuclear test by India in 1974.

He was elected as the 11th President of India in 2002 with the support of both the ruling Bhartiya Janata Party (BJP) and the opposition Indian National Congress (INC). Widely referred to as the "People's president", he returned to his civilian life of education, writing and public service after his single term. He was the recipient of several prestigious awards, including the Bharat Ratna, India's highest civilian honour.

Kalam received 7 honorary doctorates from 40 Universities. The Government of India honoured him with the Padma Bhushan in 1981 and the Padma Vibhushan in 1990 for his work with ISRO and DRDO and his role as scientific advisor to the government. In 1997, he received India's highest civilian honour, the Bharat Ratna, for his contribution to the scientific research and modernization of the defence technology in India. In 2013 he was the recipient of the Von Braun Award from the National Space Society to recognise excellence in the management and leadership of a space related project. Not only in India but Kalam was awarded across the globe. Some of them are- Honorary professor in Beijing University, China 2014, Doctor of Science in Edinburgh University, UK 2014, Doctor of laws in Simon Fraser University 2012 and many more.

While delivering a lecture at the Indian Institute of Management Shillong, Kalam collapsed and died from an apparent cardiac arrest on 27 July 2015, aged 83. Thousands, including national level dignitaries attended the funeral ceremony held in his hometown of Rameshwaram, where he was buried with full state honours.

Dr APJ Abdul Kalam was an inspiring icon for all of us.







FREEDOM FIGHTERS OF INDIA:

Shubhas Chandra Bose

On January 23, 1897, Subhash Chandra Bose was born. Later, the world came to know him as Netaji. After completing his early studies he came to Calcutta (now Kolkata). Upon completing his graduation, he came to England but he was reluctant to work under the British Government. He resigned and returned to India.

He felt that young militant groups could be moulded into a military arm of the freedom movement and used to further the cause. Gandhi opposed this ideology because it directly conflicted with his policy of Ahimsa. The British government arrested Bose and transferred him to Burma. Later upon his release he was elected as the President of Bengal Congress. Being a man of his ideals, he believed in independence from the social evils and religious discord.

By the time of WWII, it had long become evident that elite terrorism was not going to inspire a popular revolution. After Gandhi came along and demonstrated how a popular movement might be generated, the terrorists became less relevant.

Gandhi certainly saw Bose as a rival and a dangerous upstart, and did his best to destroy him politically; where Gandhi sought compromises with the British, Bose sought absolute victories.

Gandhi was willing to wait a long time for independence, Bose wanted immediate action, if not immediate results.


ब्लू व्हेल
